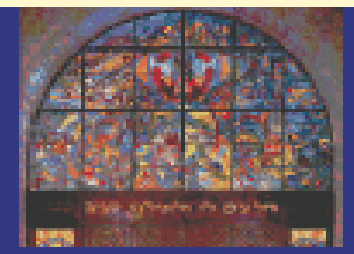

From I-95 take any street east that takes you to Biscayne Boulevard and drive on Biscayne Boulevard (from the north go south, from the south go north) to 151st Street in North Miami, turn into 151st Street heading east until you see the florescent sign on the left side of the street.
